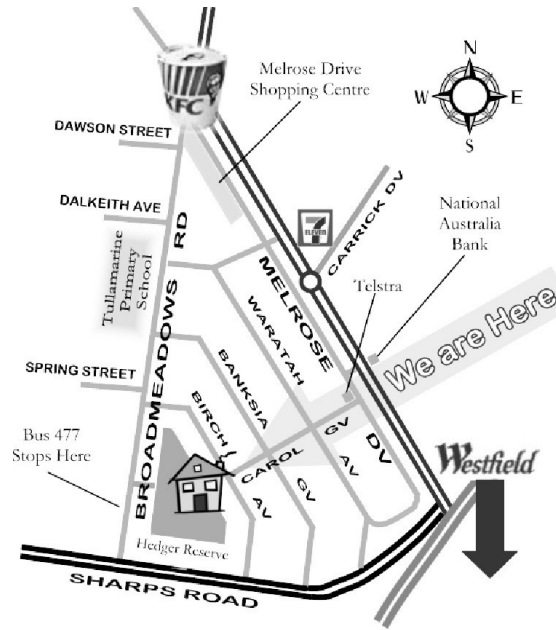
Share friendship and ideas over a meal come on down and meet us!

- ◆ Enjoy opportunities to engage socially with other members of the community

We hope to have a fully equipped work shop at the Carol Grove site along side the community house and regularly carry out fundraising activities to assist us to achieve this goal.

Current Activities:

Library:

We have a book swap library where there are no fees or fines, borrow a book, swap a book or donate a book you might like to share.

Lunch:

Join our friendly group and share the meal other men have prepared. We just need you to bring \$5 towards cost of ingredients. Pop in at 10 if you want to cook or at 12 on Mondays if you want to join us for lunch.

Garden:

The Community House has a kitchen / community garden produce is shared or eaten by the people attending activities at the House, you are welcome to join the garden crew on Thursdays if that is your passion.

Computers:

The computer group is on Friday mornings if you are a bit rusty in the IT department pop along and Maged will be pleased to assist.

Fundraising:

Work on projects:
